pedagogical innovations and efficient student management and stressed the role of the program in contributing to students' overall development.



The program showcased IIM Jammu's commitment to fostering educational leadership and excellence in the region.



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

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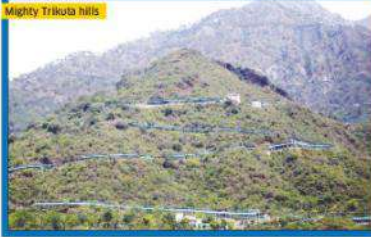
